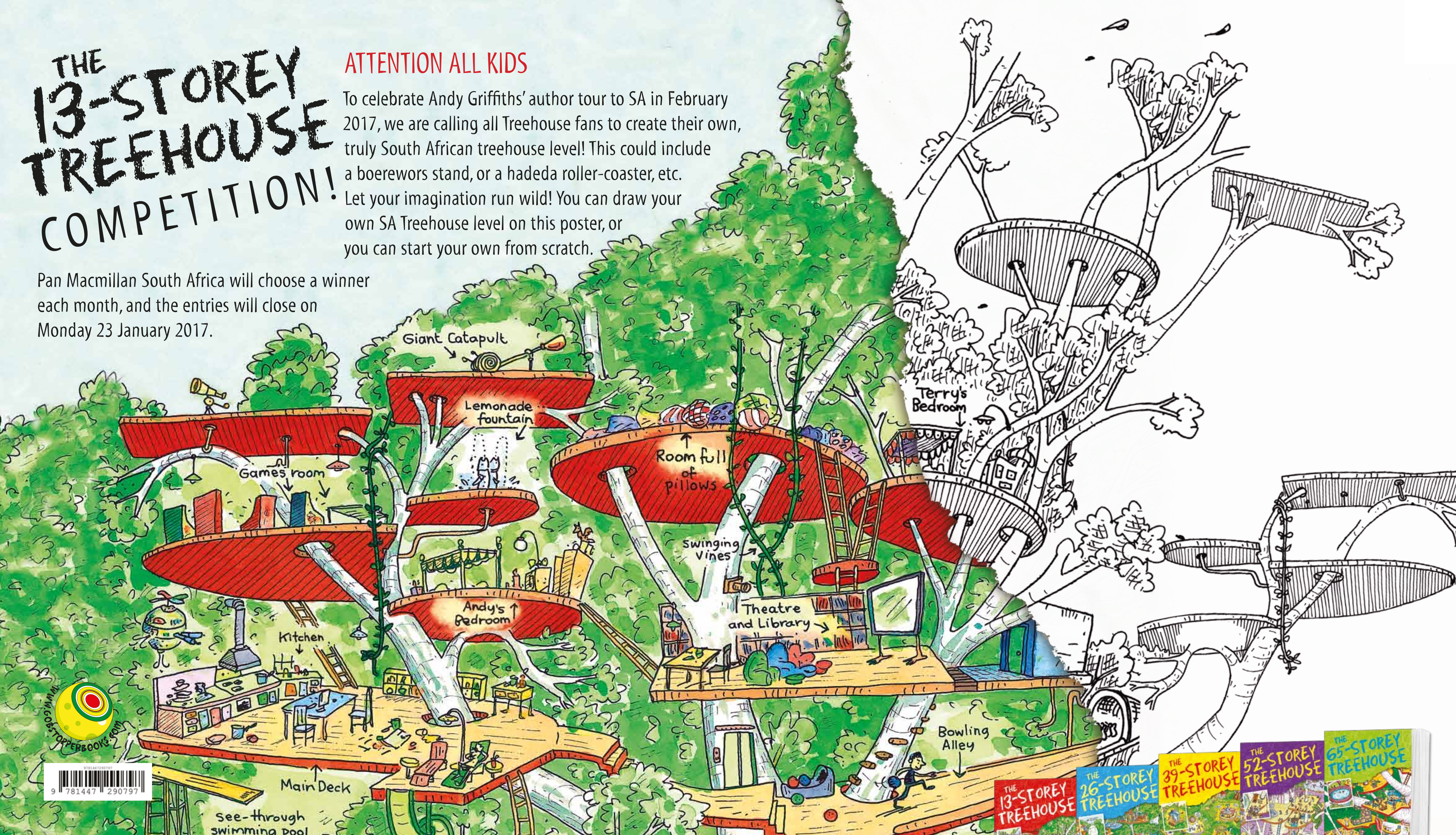


THE 13-STOREY TREEHOUSE COMPETITION!
