APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Applicants will be invited to an audition where they will be required to perform two contrasting pieces from different composers of at least Grade 4 level, scales and sight reading, which will be provided. A list of all the scales learnt should be presented. Every applicant must arange their own accompaniment.
- Candidates who play two instruments, must play the scales and sight reading on what is considered their 1st instrument and perform <u>one</u> piece on each instrument. If the level of one instrument is higher than the other, the audition should be on the 1st instrument.
- Evidence of the current theory grade must be presented or a certificate of the most recent examination passed.
- The successful applicant must commit to participating actively in the Music department, representing the School for the duration of her time at Kingsmead College in either the Orchestra, Choir or Jazz band and should offer Music as a subject from Grade 10-12.
- The involvement of the candidate in her current Music department will be considered.
