All candidates (instrumentalists and voice) are required to write a 15 minute Music Theory assessment paper after the Entrance/Scholarship Examinations at 11h15, Friday 5 May 2017. It will comprise questions of a ABRSM Grade 1 level.

If your daughter is awarded and accepts a Music Scholarship she will be expected to take Music as one of her Grade 12 subjects.

Instrumentalists: To be considered for a Music Scholarship, your daughter should be working towards at least the Grade 2 examination in one of the major streams of music i.e. Trinity, Royal Schools or UNISA.

Voice: Your daughter may be excluded from the above-mentioned criteria (instrumentalists), but will require a letter of recommendation from her vocal teacher.
