

## Competition Rules: Two Oceans Competition 2017

1. The competition runs from the 15th to 24th February 2017.

2. The competition is open to all South African citizens except directors, partners, employees, agents, service providers, family members of SABC staff/ contractors.

3. Competition entrants must be 18 years or older.

4. Entrants must be in possession of a fully paid up TV license.

5. The competition is entered by sending the keyword "TWO OCEANS", your name, answer and the area you live in to the competition short-code: 48438.

6. The competition prize does not include travel or accommodation; entrants should be able to make their own way to Cape Town.

7. Correct entries received by the advertised deadlines will be considered for the draw. Any late entries received will not be taken into consideration.

8. Each SMS will be charged at R1.50, free SMS'es are not applicable.
