REQUIREMENTS:

Bursaries are available to undergraduate students studying towards a degree.

- Eligibility Students with a gross family income of no more than R1.2m per annum
- Citizenship SA Citizen
- Programme Unrestricted
- Year of study Final 2 years of study
- GPA 60% > with no failed modules

Students to submit a 2-page statement which highlights their aim in life, reasons for their application. They must show evidence of a strong academic record and demonstrated leaderships skills and experience in extracurricular activities, community service or other areas.

- Use the following questions as a guide for your statement.
 - *Indicate the committees/clubs/organisations you belong(ed) to at High School or University, and any community service projects you have been involved with, what was/is your role and impact
 - * In what Leadership positions have you served and what impact have you had as a leader?
 - *What are your focus areas of personal development, and how are you planning to achieve this?
 - *Briefly describe a situation whereby you had to take initiative, what was the outcome?
 - *Outline your future plans and how you hope to play a role in shaping a better South Africa?
